The Parish Letter

"So long, Farewell, Auf Wiedersehen, Goodbye . . . "

Fourteen years ago I said goodbye to the folk in East Markham, the village in Nottinghamshire where we had lived for 15 years, and to the folk in the parishes of Kneesall, Laxton, and Wellow, where I had served my 3 year curacy. It was time to move on. When I read the advert for the post of part-time honorary assistant Curate in the Moorland Team there was something about it that leapt off the page - it sounded like something I could do. The then Team Rector, Derek Newport obviously thought so too as he invited us down to visit, took us all round the villages, tested me out in a school assembly, and then offered me the job.

And I've been here ever since. Like the proverbial curate's egg, life has had its good times and it's challenges. I've got to know some wonderful people, and sadly I've had to bury quite a few of them. I've been through two interregnums, seen five colleagues come and go and had three different Team Rectors. The biggest change was Ashburton joining the Team.

In many ways that was a marriage of convenience and I'm still not convinced that everyone in Ashburton is fully aware of the great privilege it is to be part of The Moorland Team! However, even marriages of convenience can work if there's enough willingness and effort put into them and I've always believed that the new enlarged Moorland Team has great potential.

I've had several different titles: Curate, Vicar of Holne, Team Vicar, "Vicar of Dibley", and the "Bird of Pray" (and probably other less complimentary ones of which I am not aware!) I've tried, but not always succeeded in doing my best, to be a good vicar - both to Holne and to the rest of the Team. Now after 14 years I've become convinced that is right for me to move on again.

I'm not sure what God has in store for me, so for the time being I shall be joining the motley crew of retired clergy living in Ashburton.

To those of you who are sorry that I'm leaving - thank you for your encouragement and support over the past 14 years. To those of you who are relieved to see me go - all I can do is ask your forgiveness for anything I have said or done or not said or done.

Whichever camp you fall in, you are warmly invited to join us for Harvest Festival at 6.00pm in Holne on 27th September. This will be my last service as Team Vicar to the Moorland Team and Vicar of Holne, and the anniversary of my licensing on a dark and stormy night way back in 2001. There'll be a "Bring and Share" supper afterwards with vicarage wine on tap for those who don't have to drive!

And whatever happens, may the Lord bless you; may the Lord keep you; may the Lord's radiant smile always shine upon you



- 5. The marquee will be cleared at 9.30 a.m. of all competitors. Only officials to remain until judges have finished..
- 6. Exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor and either grown by them or in their possession for three months (Cakes, bread, flower arrangements and handicrafts must have been produced by the exhibitor).
- 7. Constitution of the Exhibit-It must be as per schedule, neither more nor less than the number or qty.
- 8. Any exhibit not as schedule will be disqualified.
- 9. After judging, no entry to be altered or moved until the end of the show.
- 10.Exhibits may be removed between 4.30 and 5.00 p.m..
- 11. The show committee wish to make it clearly understood that they will not be responsible for any accident occurring to spectators or for the damage or loss of property.
