

The Parish Letter

A very happy New Year to you all.

When the people of God stood on the banks of the Jordan ready to cross to the Promised Land they were assured, 'you have never been this way before' (Joshua 3:4). At the beginning of a New Year, we don't know what the future holds or whether we will keep our resolutions.

On 6th January we celebrate the Epiphany, the coming of the Magi to Bethlehem and the gifts they brought for the child Jesus - gold, frankincense and myrrh. Gold because he was King of the Jews, frankincense because he was to be worshipped as divine; and myrrh, because he would also become a sacrifice and die for his people.

When these wise men saw the star they left their home, probably in Persia, and set out on a long journey, the Magi 'had never been this way before'.

They came to worship Jesus the Messiah. The Wise Men were the very first non-Jews ever to worship Jesus. What faith they had! They travelled for months over difficult terrain, they never saw any evidence of Jesus' kingship, his divinity or his sacrificial death. They worshipped him through faith in God's promises about him. Isaiah foresaw this response to Jesus: 'Nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn.' The Magi's eyes of faith saw clearly and far into the future.

Compare that with the High Priest and religious leaders whom the Wise Men saw in Jerusalem when they first arrived. These head priests knew all about the prophecies of their own coming Messiah, but NOT ONE Jewish religious leader travelled to look for him in Bethlehem. And it is only six miles down the road!

So, as we begin 2016 let us walk into the unknown with Jesus, the light of the world. Jesus came for the people who walked in darkness and there are many who are walking in darkness today. We pray that they may see the light of Christ. Help us, as Christians, to shine your light into the darkness; for those caught up in crime to find another way; for refugees to find acceptance; for those in fear and conflict to know God's love and to pray for peace in the world.

May you have a peaceful and blessed 2016.

However, many Christians are afraid to invite their friends and family. Reasons can include: 'I don't want my friend to suffer in church like I do', 'What if it damages my friendship?' and 'I don't want to be seen as strange'.

But we as Christians should go ahead with their invitation, anyway. "Noah looked strange building an ark in the desert and the Wise Men looked strange following yonder star. We may fear being ridiculed, but we actually need to become less self-conscious. If we wait for the perfect church, then we'll never invite anyone."

Queen's 90th Birthday

As a church community we are being encouraged to plan something for the weekend of 10-12 June 2016 to celebrate the Queen's 90th birthday and her role as head of the Church of England. The variety of potential forms for the celebrations is huge, from flower festivals to organ recitals, bell-ringing or choir festivals – and it is hoped that, wherever possible, every church will take part.

In addition, to coincide with the Queen's birthday it is hoped that every church will be able to organise an exhibition of the life of its parish over the previous 90 years. Such exhibitions should, by charting the changes in the lives of our communities since 1926. highlight the ways in which parish churches have been and remain the focus of those communities, and be a celebration both of our churches and of the people that they serve. 



A New Year

With carol services and Christmas now in the past, our thoughts turn to the year ahead. The snowdrops are already showing through the grass which surrounds the Chapel, so once again we are promised a wonderful display. Do come and visit in February, even if you have been before. Further snowdrop news next month.

2016 is 'Quinquenniel' year for several of the churches on Dartmoor including St Raphael's. All Anglican church buildings have to be inspected by a specialist architect every five years. A report is produced about the condition of the building.

These inspections are very thorough and the report usually contains many recommendations which are graded according to the urgency or importance of the issue. The Churchwardens are then responsible for ensuring that the necessary repairs and maintenance are carried out.

Our last inspection was conducted in 2011 and I am pleased to report that thanks to several grants, the generosity of individuals and some hard graft by a small team of volunteers, all the work listed in the recommendations of the 2011 report, has been completed along with some additional improvements.

Sustaining Rural Churches

Further to the item in last month's Link regarding the addition of a composting toilet, Dartmoor Forest Parish Council has made a generous grant towards the cost – many thanks! At the time of writing the results of other grant applications are awaited and any donations towards this project will be very welcome.

Pleasingly, requests are being made to use the Chapel for events and activities in addition to Sunday services. The acoustics in the building are very good and there is flexibility in using the space.
