



The Parish Letter

God is now here December 2018

An atheist was writing an article for Christmas to prove that God did not exist. He wanted to finish it with the sentence: 'God is nowhere!' Unfortunately, the sub editors made a mistake with his copy and so the final sentence read: 'God is now here!'

This is the heart of the Christmas good news. We celebrate that God came to us in human form, as a vulnerable baby to a young woman called Mary. In very ordinary circumstances, Jesus was born in a particular place- the small town of Bethlehem on the edge of the Roman Empire and at a specific time – when Augustus was Emperor. St John says: 'the Word became flesh and dwelt among us'. St Matthew retells the words of the prophet: 'the virgin shall conceive and bear a son and they shall name him Emmanuel' which means 'God is with us'. God is now here.

For many this is unbelievable. Surely if God was to reveal himself to us he would just rend the heavens and come down. Indeed, a philosopher said: 'some people seem to think that it would help if one day there was a large banner displayed in the sky saying, 'I'm up here, you idiots.' However, God seems to work not by breaking into the world but by embracing the world from within. In Charles Wesley's carol, 'Hark the herald Angels sing', we sing the lines: 'Pleased as man with man to dwell, Jesus our Emmanuel'. Take away the traditional 'man' language and we see that it is saying that God delights to be human alongside human beings. This carol tells of a God who does not have to be lured down from heaven by us being very polite to him or behaving extra well. We are dealing with a God who can't help pouring himself out for the world that he has made. This is a God who doesn't have to be persuaded to be interested in us.

Perhaps a first practical exercise in prayer is to approach God with this in mind: he is interested in us. Christmas teaches us to dispel the idea that God is essentially bored with us, rather removed from us and always in need of being kept sweet. He does not have to be persuaded to be on our side. As a former Archbishop of Canterbury said, 'You might as well try to persuade a waterfall to be wet.'

In Bethlehem, God comes to us in the weakness of a baby. A lifetime later, at Calvary, he appeals to us in the helplessness of a man nailed to a cross. In Jesus, God beckons to us not by force or command but in solidarity and by identifying with us. He longs for us to recognise him and go to him.

God is now here. He values our humanity beyond all imagining. He shares our struggles as well as our joys. 'Pleased as man with man to dwell, Jesus our Emmanuel.' God is with us. God is for us. May you know the blessing of his presence this Christmas.

<u>Provision of local housing in Princetown</u> Alex Rehaag, West Devon Borough Council (WDBC), updated the meeting on the potential of affordable, housing development for local people on the old stores site near Moorland View, Princetown. This is at an early stage of discussion and would require community support and an updated housing needs survey, to determine what kind of housing would be required. The development could be for around 12 dwellings and for low rent or purchase and limited to those with a strong connection to Princetown. Concern was raised from some members of the public about potential access and parking issues due to the narrow road leading to the site.

Public toilets costs Cllr. Annabel Roberts, West Devon Borough Councillor for Dartmoor ward, updated the meeting on WDBC's recent plans on how to manage public toilet costs and its potential impact to Princetown and Dartmoor Forest Parish Council. WDBC had agreed that Parish and Town Councils are requested to either assume responsibility for the public toilets in their area, including a transfer of the freehold or leasehold property, or to make a contribution towards the cost of running public toilets equivalent to 75% of all direct costs (which includes staff and management costs). This is with effect from the next financial year. It was also resolved that the 75% contribution be increased over the following three years to reach a point where full costs are covered by Town and Parish Councils. This could result in the DFPC precept increasing by £13,496 on 2018/19, a 78.11% increase. The Clerk presented some approximate estimates on the impact to each individual household in the parish; in 2018/19 the precept would increase from £44 to £80, rising to £106 in 2022/23 if the council assumed 100% of service costs. WDBC are investigating the introduction of 'paddle gate' or turnstile type entry, which should increase the revenue of the facility and therefore reduce the running costs. However, no estimates of the potential impact of this were available at the meeting. The council resolved to communicate to West Devon Borough Council that they are not supportive of their proposal, for the public toilet in Princetown to be transferred to the parish council OR for the parish council to increase its contribution to 75% of all direct costs, increasing over the following three years to reach a point where full costs are covered by the council. The council resolved that Dartmoor National Park Authority, as the freeholders of the toilets in Princetown, should be responsible for paying the running costs of the facility and request that West Devon Borough Council raise this directly with them.
