

The Parish Letter

From Geoffrey:

The clocks have gone back, the rain has come back, the schools are all back, and nostalgia looks back... Some people find the approach of winter really challenging, often feeling depressed as it gets darker and gloomier and the day-length shortens. Another summer has passed, another winter to get through. It was a wonderful summer, and it seems hard to say goodbye to it.

I guess everyone's mood is affected by the seasons and the weather. But it can go either way – I love sunny autumn days, with all their mellow colours, and I look forward to evenings in with the fire alight and our spaniel comfortably stretched out on the hearth-rug.

It's not just the weather that affects our mood. Lots of different things come into it. I wonder how you are feeling today? Bright and cheerful? About average? A bit miserable? What will you say to the next person who asks "How are you?" Will you just say "Fine", because you suspect they don't really want to know, it's just an automatic greeting? Maybe you can tell them a bit more, though it can be really hard to talk about what we are really feeling. Yet when we do it can be a great relief.

Jesus had a wonderful way of getting people to tell him all about themselves – he gave them his full attention and seemed to look deep into their hearts. And many of the people he met were miserable – blind beggars, people with leprosy or other illness, mean people, self-centred people – and they all found themselves telling him everything. He listened and then helped them see what they could change to make their lives better. And his message was pretty much the same to all of them – stop thinking so much about yourself, instead start caring for other people – love your neighbour, focus on God. Give away more money. Pray. Seek forgiveness. Tell God how you are feeling, and try thanking God that he loves you. And it's the same today – talk to Jesus yourself – you don't need to say the words out loud! Christians find that by getting to know Jesus through reading the gospels and praying to him, he can transform their lives just as he transformed the lives of those around him in Galilee.

One common mood is loneliness – one of the saddest stories to hit headlines in recent weeks is the revelation that millions of people, of all ages, are feeling lonely and are unhappy about being lonely. It's a hidden problem because people who just sit in their room all day simply can't be seen. And I guess that as the days pass it becomes harder and harder to get out, to make an effort, with a growing sense that nobody cares, nobody has time to listen. This is a major issue that we can all do something about. If you are lonely, you may be able to go out to find other people – have you tried finding your way to a church on a Sunday, where there will be a warm welcome and people to talk to, and the sense of being noticed and cared for. Or, maybe, go to a coffee morning or a café.

But across our communities we also need a bigger plan to tackle loneliness -



Not that the Fair is all about money, but we'll share a first cut of the 2018 financial numbers and we are sure the Chairman will want to say a few words and thank everyone personally


We stress this will all be relaxed and very much a 'drop in' event rather than anything more formal

- 8. The Council then vote whether to SUPPORT, OBJECT or NO OBJECTION/NEUTRAL VIEW. Cllrs. Can also abstain on the vote.
- 9. The Council's decision and comments should be material considerations: www.planningportal.co.uk/faqs/faq/4/what are material considerations
- 10. After the meeting the Clerk emails the relevant with planning officer with the Council's decision and comments which are uploaded to the DNPA planning site.

 Anti-social driving Update on Actions John Ward, anti-social behaviour officer at WDBC, has confirmed the procedure for issuing Community Protection Notices; a member of the public will capture the information about the crime and be willing to make a statement. This will be passed onto the Clerk for collating and sending to Mr Ward. Residents should also be encouraged to report incidents to Police to ensure that full picture of the incidents is captured. It was resolved that a letter is issued to all residents of Princetown to update them on this and encourage reporting of incidents. Clerk to draft letter for agreement at next month's meeting.

<u>Fire & Rescue Service</u> Council had received bulletin from a campaign group; 'Stop Fire Cuts Devon & Somerset' detailing concerns about the introduction of Rapid Intervention Units(RIV), as has been implemented in Princetown.
