

### The Parish Letter

#### Geoffrey Boycott and God

A few years ago I was invited to watch England play West Indies in a Test cricket match at Trent Bridge. Sunshine, good company and some superb cricket –it was a fantastic day. But the day became even better when I met Geoffrey Boycott, the former England batsman and commentator on Test Match Special. My host knew him and he got a text message from Geoffrey inviting us to join him when he had a break in between his commentary work. So we did! On a balcony overlooking the cricket right behind the bowler's arm – the best spot. We had half an hour together. I have to say I was a bit overawed and tongue-tied in the presence of the great man. But I needn't have worried because Boycott loves talking about cricket and enjoys giving his opinions to anyone who will listen. So we had a conversation together. In truth, it was more like an audience: he spoke and we listened.

Towards the end of the conversation, I summoned up the courage to ask him some questions about my own batting. I've always had trouble executing the square cut on the offside and the clip off the legs. Sorry if this sounds technical...I wont go into details... but I was amazed at the way the great man responded to me. I was expecting some disdainful comments and a few brief directions from Boycott that would put me straight on the matter. But I was wrong. He suddenly became animated; asked me to show him how I stood at the crease and tried to play the shots. He found a bat and got me to play the shots again. Then he stood by me and showed me how my balance was all wrong for the cut shot and I was not getting my angles right for the leg side shot. I am a left handed batsman. He is right handed. But, for my benefit, he demonstrated playing left handed. He then stood right by me so I could copy him – how to play the different strokes. There on the balcony at Trent Bridge, in the middle of a Test Match, I was given a coaching session by Geoffrey Boycott. He listened carefully, gave encouragement and really helped me. He didn't just tell me what to do, he stood by me and showed me the way.

This month we celebrate Pentecost on 9th June, the day when the Church celebrates the coming of the Holy Spirit on the first followers of Jesus Christ. One of the names used for the Holy Spirit by Jesus is 'paraclete' which means 'helper', one who 'stands by you' and 'pleads for you'. Jesus did not leave the disciples when he ascended to heaven and just tell his followers to get on with his work. He commanded them to wait for 'the power from

#### The life and experiences of a Churchwarden

I suspect that even many regular church goers only have a vague idea of what the role of a churchwarden entails. Of course, although there are some important legal responsibilities, other duties will vary depending on the location of the church, the area, the population and the size of the congregation.

In churches located within areas of small populations such as the Moorland churches, churchwardens usually have to be multi-functional. Not for us the luxury of building committees, fund-raising committees or multitudes of volunteers. Usually we are supported by a few, hardworking and committed people who care about their church and appreciate whatever the churchwardens do.

After election at the Annual Parish Church meeting, all churchwardens have to attend an Archdeacon's Visitation Service to be formally admitted to the role. I was very struck by something that Archdeacon Douglas Dettmer said a couple of years ago about a key role being able to provide support to the incumbent as well as representing the laity. So we act as a sounding board and try to look after the incumbent as best we can to ensure they can do their job without too many distractions.

Perhaps, the most well-known parts of the role are being responsible for the fabric of the church building, health and safety, being a point of contact for visiting priests and ensuring that all church records are properly maintained. Understanding and promoting the importance of safeguarding is another vital responsibility.

The role also requires the ability to respond to enquiries about times of services, weddings, funerals and other church offices. Sometimes, however, the enquiries can be a little unusual.

"I'm a former priest. Can I 'wild camp' in the churchyard at Holne while on the Two Moors Walk?"

"I'm an ordained Nun from Wales on a silent retreat. Can I conduct a silent service at St. Raphael's?"

"We met in Dave Mudge's field some years ago. Now we want to get married at St. Raphael's. Will we meet the residential gualifications?"

"I've left my robes in the Vestry. Is it possible to pick them up and meet half-way as I may need them soon?"

"I'm doing my family tree; can you check the Registers for me?"





#### Results were as follows:



#### **News from East Shallowford Farm**

The East Shallowford Trust said a sad farewell to Debbie and Alastair Sandels just before Easter. Debbie has been the Trust manager for over five years, and in that time hundreds of city children have experienced life on the farm – life-changing visits, continuing the work that Elizabeth Braund started over 40 years, when she set the Trust up as a Christian Charity. Debbie's role grew and grew, so she has been replaced by two people – Julia McDade as Manager, and Alethe Virgin as Resident Warden. Both are now in place.

#### Julia writes:

"In the last two weeks, we watched a lady lie down on the grass, close her eyes and cry, as she felt the sun warm her grey skin that so rarely sees rays of glowing light. Another opened her lungs to cough saying, 'I would give up these 'orrd fags if I lived 'ere, but there's no point in London.'

This week we took ducks, chickens and geese to Exeter Crown Court for 'health and well-being week'; planned enthusiastically for the next round of school visits for which Will, our farm manager, is developing complex mathematical questions about stocking rates, carbon sinks on the marshes and how mixed herbal leys can also reduce Britain's carbon emissions by counteracting the methane burping cows. The involuntary smile. The 'awww – they are so cute', the enthusiasm for physical work, knowing it is needed and worthy...Shallowford does it all and people's hearts are lifted and relieved."

#### Alethe writes:

"I'm sitting at my desk fully intending to write an amusing and informative piece – but it's far too easy to 'lift my eyes to the quiet hills' and watch the clouds scudding through a blue sky. The birds are twittering and the cockerel (Christopher Columbus) has an attempt at crowing every now and then, but otherwise there is silence.

I've been coming out to the farm for a number of years now as a volunteer. Having grown up in this part of Devon I've always just accepted the Moor as my playground – going for a walk in the wide-open spaces was what we did as a family at the weekends. It took a tearful Mum from Battersea to help me see my Devon through fresh eyes. I knew then that I needed to share with others what I had always taken for granted. So supporting East Shallowford took over my life. Being guardian of the farm is both privilege and huge responsibility in ensuring that all is kept secure for future generations to enjoy and appreciate."


